Commercial name: Complex nitrogenous phosphorous potassium fertilizers
Synonyms: Fertilizers NPK
Substance destination: **Preplant broadcast application: soybeans, coloured beans, peas etc. Incorporate once and shallow, to a maximum depth of 2-2.5 inches. May also be banded in no-till systems. Due to high level of potassium, it is not recommended to apply "with" seed.**

2. Hazards identification

Classification: NPK fertilizer is not classified as dangerous according to Regulation 67/548/EEC and 1999/45/EC

Physical and chemical hazard(s): While heating at more than 190 C monoammophos begins to disintegrate forming ammonia

Possible human health hazard: Prolonged contact with the skin or eyes can cause irritation. In case of large inhalation product dust can irritation of the respiratory tract. In the case of fire, the product can breakdown at a high temperature releasing toxic gases.

For the environment: Large scale or repeated discharge of the product into stagnant water can cause algae to proliferate.
